

OFFICIAL POPULATION 1947
T.E. Yakel, county house number coordinator, reveals that as of June 30, the official population of Alpine is 1947. This does not mean all the fire or school districts. but Alpine proper. It is based on a national factor of 3.29 arrived at by utility, phone and postoffice figures throughout the nation.


