on So. Grade Road in Alpine. Fred tells me he has had 11,000 hours of flying, many of which were spent in teaching, as he says many older men are now taking up flying. I was surprised to learn that it takes only 8 to 10 hours to solo, with these modern, safe Tri-pacers.

Government records' Fred says 'show that students 50 to 55 have a safety record five times better than those 20 to 25, showing that safety depends more on commonsense than on youthful reflexes'.

Well, maybe someday I'll have enough time and spare cash to go for this wonderful flying business!'
