Here is the summing up for: governor, Brown 361, Knowland 444; senator, Engle and Knight tied for 397; congressman, Wilson 473, Van Deerlin 319; state senator, Kraft 380, Fisher 394 and for assemblyman, Schrade 437, Bear 353.

On the two chief propositions, 16 had 328 yes and 450 no, while 18 had 385 yes and 406 no.

## If You Lived in Hawaii You Could NOT Vote!



When we exercised our hard-earned privilege to vote on Tuesday, most of us probably never gave a thought to our

fellow Americans over in the Territory of Hawaii who have no vote!

Having lived there two different periods, I know how it feels to be a 'second class citizen'; how it hurts to ask for your vote, the vote that all taxpayers are supposed to have under our Bill of Rights.

Just think of this. When you reside in this U.S. territory, you pay federal income taxes. You are subject to the draft law, yet you are deprived of naming the president, a senator or a representative, even the governor.

Why congress gave Alaska statehood and passed up Hawaii is more than anyone can fathom. The president is for it and both parties favor it. Also national polls have endorsed it.

Perhaps now would be a good time for us to write notes to our representatives that we would like to see Hawaii made a state. The good people out there have been trying for 50 years to win their place on our flag.

Let's help these fellow Americans get their rightful vote by urging congress to act at the next session.-CI

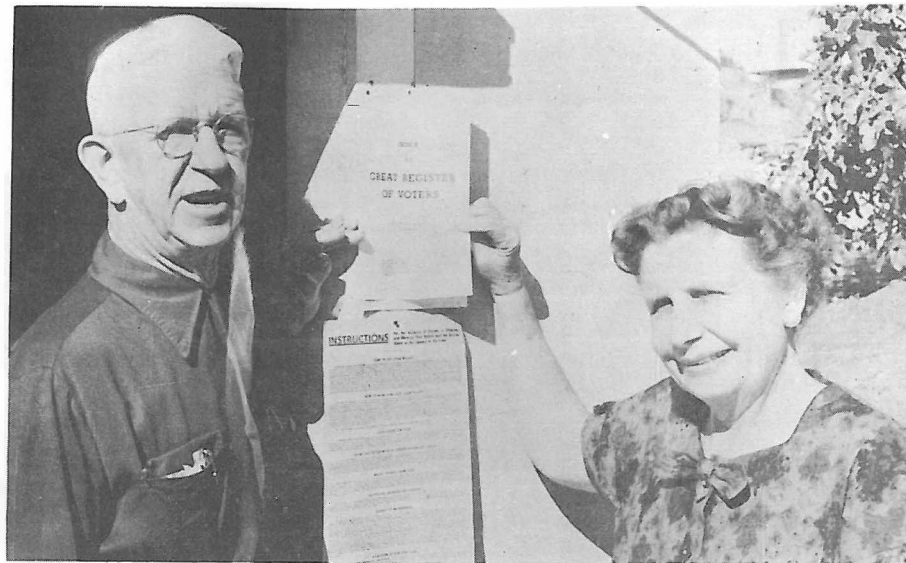

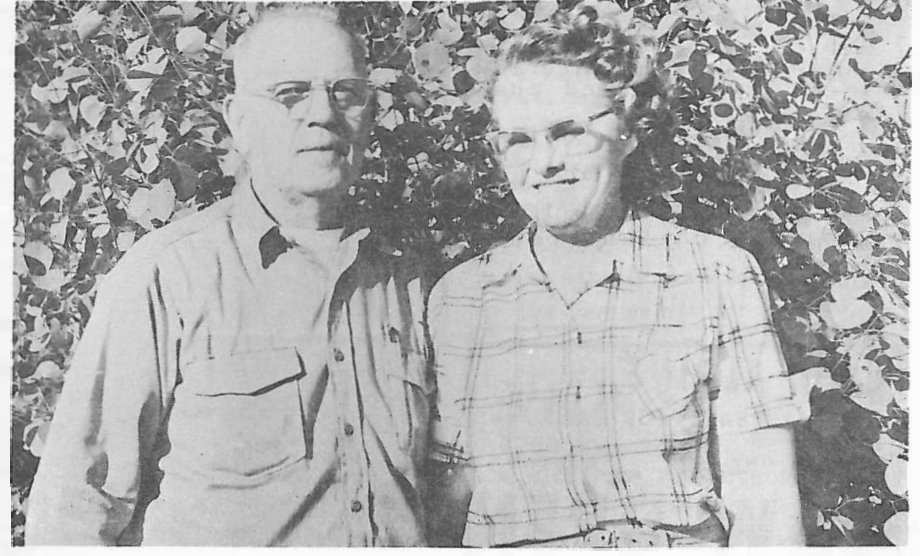

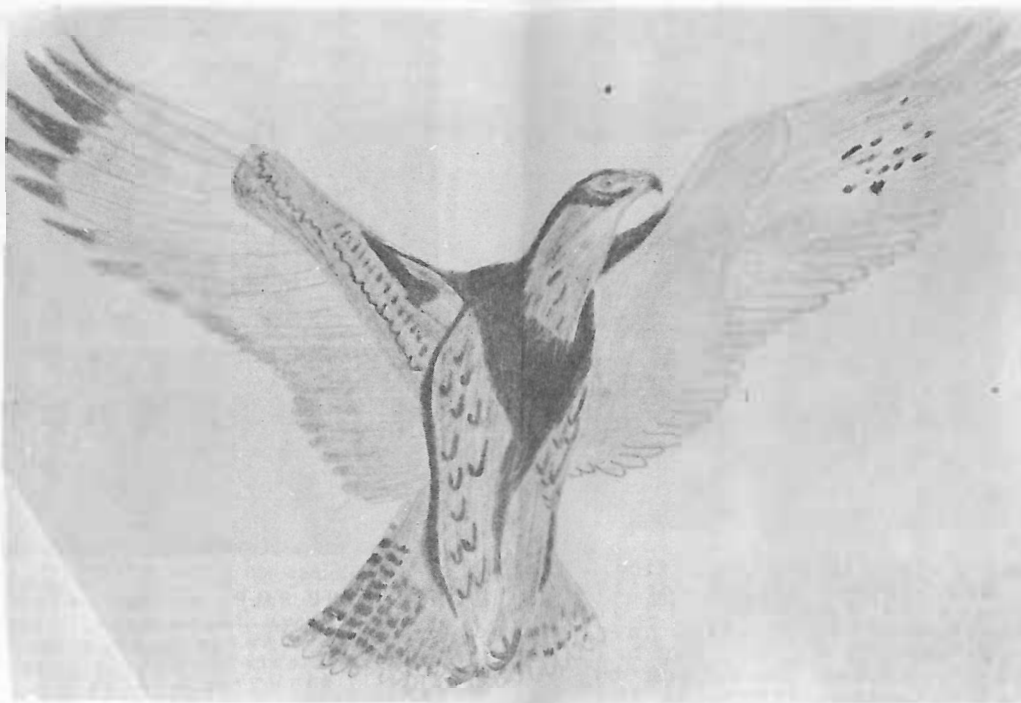
Sunday afternoon from 4 to 7 Alpine's sorority girls dished out delicious turkey dinners to delighted customers.

Elizabeth Setser's childhood was spent in Tyler, Texas. After her graduation from high school, she attended North Texas College in Denton, where she received her B.S. degree. She was married to Roy Setser in December, 1929.

They made their home in the eastern part of Texas until they moved to San Diego in 1941. Alpine has been their home for 12 years and today they are living in 'Cozy Bend', the house in the bend of the road just as you turn up Alpine Terrace from Arnold Way.
