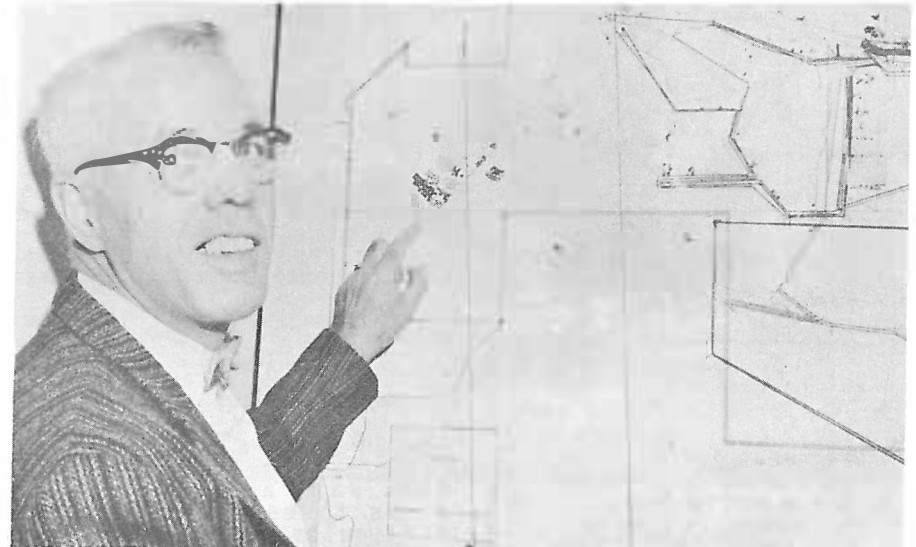

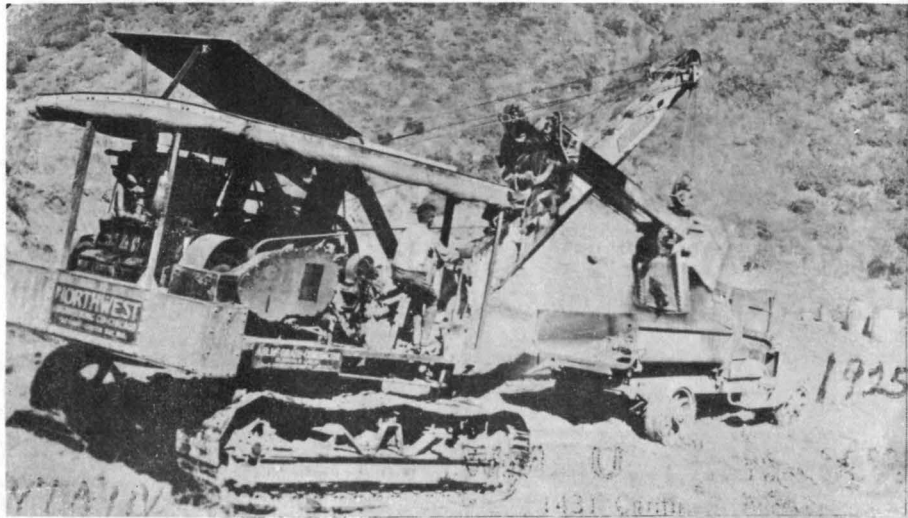

### REVEAL HWY 80 PROGRESS

There is a meeting slated tentatively for the middle of January when state highway engineers will exhibit the result of their studies which have now been completed on the relocation of Hwy 80 in Alpine.

J. F. Jorgensen, assistant to Jacob Dekema, in charge, told the Sun at presstime that the session will be in Alpine School so the public may see and hear what has been done engineering-wise.

"The road will go either to the north, or south, of the present route" he stated. "To the north it is somewhat steeper, but has an easier grade. Either way it will serve equally well. The opinions of the people and the engineering data will be studied for ultimate decision by the engineers"

### CANCER FROM SMOKING

Two main factors in smoking cigarettes have been shown to cause cancer, a leading authority has just announced.

Dr. E.V. Cowdry, St. Louis, head of a research institute, says "excessive cigarette smoking has been conclusively proven to produce cancer of the lungs".

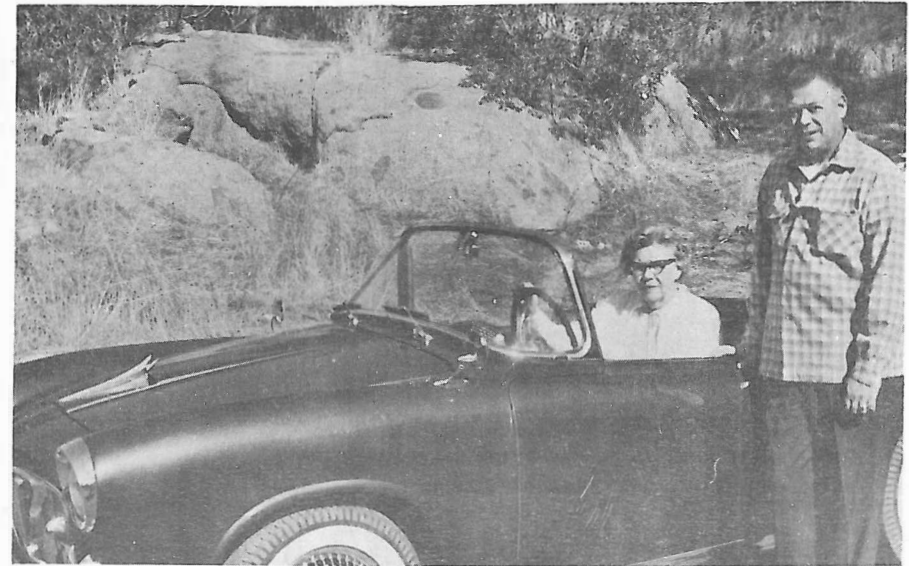
