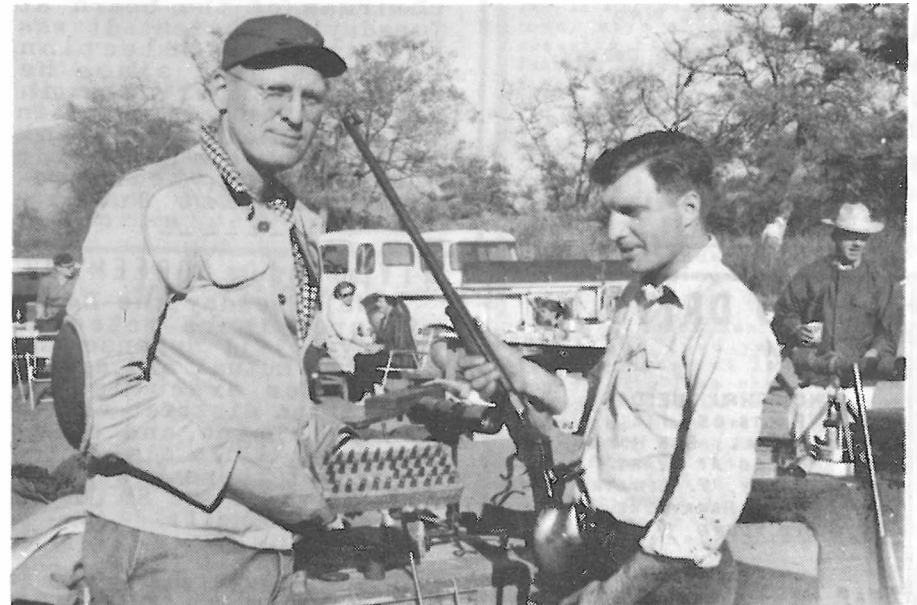

EDITORIAL

What Mental Quirk Causes Vandalism?

The usual newspaper editorial takes a slam at someone or something

This one is merely asking a question. What peculiar trait of mentality produces vandalism, especially

in juveniles?

The query is sparked by a visit to the vacant home once occupied by Mr. and Mrs. Sidney Wright, who died here last year. The place is off a side road, deserted.

But it has had visitors. When vacated, it was in good, living order. Today it is a shambles. The garage and a guest house are riddled with holes as is the main house. Not a pane of glass remains and most sash are broken, screens torn off, and fixtures strewn around the once beautiful yard. (See photos elsewhere).

Wright left the place with its 245 acres to the Episcopal Church in SD, which has no immediate plans, but hopes someday, The Rev. Paul Satrang declares, to use it for a retired ministers' home, perhaps a parochial school later, and maybe in time, a church. There was no tenant or caretaker, hence the defenseless buildings were wide open to vandals.

It seems a crying shame that a good, usable dwelling should be so nearly destroyed for no sane reason. We only ask the question, why this strange twist to the human brain that allows such sacrilege? -CI

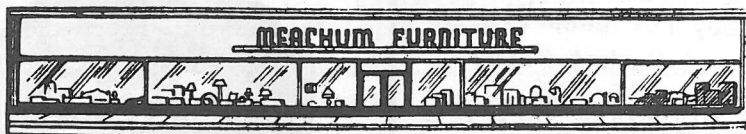

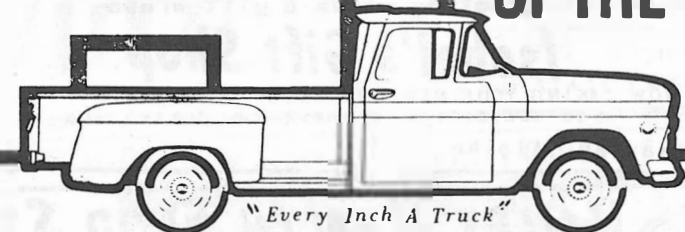
