



Last year proposals to force drinking water fluoridation on the American people were defeated in 43 out of 56 elections. The November elections revealed that all such measures were defeated.

This is only one facet of a trend to take the rights away from the people. Petitions on this, parking meters, lot-splitting and other questions show that politicians do not want to carry out the will of electors. Something drastic must be done if freedom is to be retained.

Nicholason set hours of the new branch from 10 am to 6 pm Mondays thru Saturdays. He won it on a low bid of \$900 for an 11-month period.






